

Call for a countrywide protest against the federal party convent of the AFD in Wiesbaden

From December 10 to 12 the AFD plans to hold their federal party convent in the Rhein-Main-Congress Center in Wiesbaden. We do not want them to succeed and will take a stand against them.

Alliance call: Stand up in solidarity against the federal party convent of the AFD in Wiesbaden from December 10 to 12

The AFD's brand core consists of right-wing defamation, antimuslim racism and the denial of the crimes of National Socialism. Their positions on social, ecological and pandemic questions threaten the lives of all people who do not conform to the limited world view of the AFD, as well as all those who care about a worthwhile future for all.

The AFD is the nucleus of a new fascism in Germany as the past elections have clearly shown. We will not accept that an inherently fascist party is able to establish itself on a countrywide scale by a vote of 10,3 percent, thus becoming the dominant power in Thuringia and Saxony.

It is to be expected that the nationalist-racist Höcke-wing will assert itself against the nationalist-conservative Meuthen-wing in the upcoming internal party elections.

Despite all efforts to take the disguise as a bourgeois party, it is more than obvious: The AFD is the parliamentary arm of racist and right-wing terror. Their members act as intellectual incendiaries spreading hatred and defamation with deadly consequences.

The assassins of Halle and Hanau referred to racist and anti-Semitic conspiracy myths, as they are being spread by AFD politicians within the parliaments. Recently the politically motivated murder in Idar-Oberstein left us shocked when a young student was killed by a mask refuser and AFD-supporter. Right-wing violence is commonplace in Germany. Within the political sector concepts as delivered by the far right have long since been taken up, culminating into inhuman political decisions. The European 'closed borders' and deportation policies lead to the deaths of thousands of people in the Mediterranean Sea.

If we are to prevent a further spread of inhuman AFD policies, we have to take action now.

Otherwise there are reasons to fear further shifts to the right in public discourse that will be very difficult to reverse.

76 years after the end of the Nazi regime the oath sworn by the survivors of the Buchenwald concentration camp remains our obligation: "(...) The eradication of Nazi fascism is our pledge. The construction of a new world of peace and freedom is our goal."

Let us confront the Nazis and racists of the AFD together. Diverse, loud, colorful and determined!

We appeal to all people countrywide to demonstrate resistance against the AFD's neo-fascism and to join the protests for a plural and tolerant society of solidarity.
